SUMMARY OF THE PROJECT IDEA:

In this project, we would like to look at volunteering projects from both sides - organization and volunteer. What are those challenges organizations and volunteers are facing? How to fully engage volunteers in organization everyday life and allow them to feel a sense of belonging to the organization. How to support the learning process and personal growth of the volunteers? What does it mean magical touch and how to put magic in volunteering projects? Through the various activities, participants will develop skills to implement and improve volunteering projects what could bring positive and magical changes for both - volunteers and organizations.

The overall objective of the project "Bring the Magic in Volunteering" is to raise the quality of volunteering projects and to improve the quality of work with young people, in particular by improving cooperation between youth organizations and/or other stakeholders.

Ⅲ PROJECT OBJECTIVES:

- Promote awareness of the quality of implementation volunteering projects in ESC program and other local & international programs and ensure the sustainability of partner organizations;
- Using NFL methods to develop participants' personal and professional competences for further work on volunteering project implementation;
- Share personal experiences about volunteering project implementation and to exchange best practices and failures in the projects;
- Generally promote the improvement of the quality of work with youth and cooperation between organizations.

THE MAIN ACTIVITY OF THE PROJECT:

The training course will use a variety of methods, such as individual and group work, games, simulation tasks, discussions, debates, etc. Activities will be run by both, trainers and participants themselves, implementing approach "Learning by doing". In the project non-formal learning approaches will be included - Learning by doing, Learning to learn, Learning to be with others, Learning to be.



THE MAIN IMPACT OF THE PROJECT ON PARTICIPANTS:

They will develop competencies in the implementation of E+:YiA mobility projects and ESC projects in order in future to carry out more qualitative projects and, in general, to carry out more professional work with young people.



TRAINING PLACE:

The training course will be held in Limbažu district, guest house "Vecmuiža" (around 75 km from Riga), but the last day activities will take place in Riga, at the youth studio "BaMbuss".
